Thank you for your interest in Project READY: Reimagining Equity and Access for Diverse Youth!

For the first time in American history, youth of color, many of whom are English Language Learners, make up the majority of students in U.S. public schools. Project READY was created to help school librarians, classroom teachers, and literacy coaches develop the skills they will need to effectively serve diverse youth.

Funded by a grant from the Institute for Museum and Library Services (IMLS), Project READY will engage participants in learning about cultural competency, culturally sustaining pedagogy (CSP), and equity literacy.

Thirty teams of WCPSS educators will be chosen to participate in Project READY. Each team will consist of one school librarian, one classroom teacher, and one literacy coach (or another staff member with expertise in reading and writing).

Participating teams will be required to:

- attend and fully participate in five days of face-to-face professional development (July 10-14, July 24-28, or August 7-11);
- implement culturally sustaining teaching and equity literacy practices in their school;
- participate in a series of three webinars over the course of the 2017-2018 school year;
- provide one building-level professional development session for colleagues in their school; and
- agree to the project's research components (click here to read the research consent form; you will be asked to sign a printed copy on the first day of training).

Because of the time and attention required, it is important to include your building principal in discussions about participation. Be sure to review this application with her/him in order to gain their full support and to ensure they know the commitment required. After your application is submitted, your principal will receive an email requesting her/his endorsement of your team's application.

All applications must be submitted by Tuesday, February 28, 2017, and applicants will be notified no later than March 31, 2017.
